Rules and Guidelines for Re-Admission / Ex-studentship

A candidate is allowed for **Re-admission** provided he/she satisfies one of the following conditions:

1. A candidate is declared fail.
2. A candidate did not appear in a semester examination or he/she was not granted permission to appear in the examination.
3. A candidate has been detained by the institute and subsequently has been permitted to take re-admission.
4. A candidate as an Ex-student passed the examination of the academic year or qualified for carryover system.
5. A candidate promoted with carry over subjects and he/she opted for re-admission.

A candidate is allowed for **Ex-studentship** provided he/she satisfies one of the following conditions.

1. A candidate opting for Ex-studentship shall be required to appear in all the theory & practical subjects in the end semester examinations of both semesters of the same academic year. However, the marks pertaining to Sessional, Industrial Training, Seminar and General Proficiency shall remain the same as those secured earlier.
2. A candidate opting for Ex-studentship shall be required to apply to the college by paying only examination fee within 15 days from the start of new session.
